PPE Update for Providers

The Louisiana Department of Health is urging all providers to communicate with their PPE suppliers/vendors immediately. They have received notification from FEMA that FEMA will be sending additional inventory to regular suppliers today. They are asking that in addition to communicating your needs through GOHSEP that you also check with your normal vendors to see if they can more quickly provide your supplies.

Again, for your convenience, the directive from the Louisiana Department of Health related to obtaining PPE through GOHSEP is below:

1. To the extent possible, please continue to use the vendor/supply chain you would normally to request such supplies.
2. We are keeping a list of unique vendors (as they become made known to us) on our website, and you may be able to receive supplies more quickly by purchasing from them directly. 3. You can call the State Supply Hotline at **225-325-5900** to be put on our list as supplies become available. This line is open 8:00 am – 5:00 pm CST; 7 days a week.
